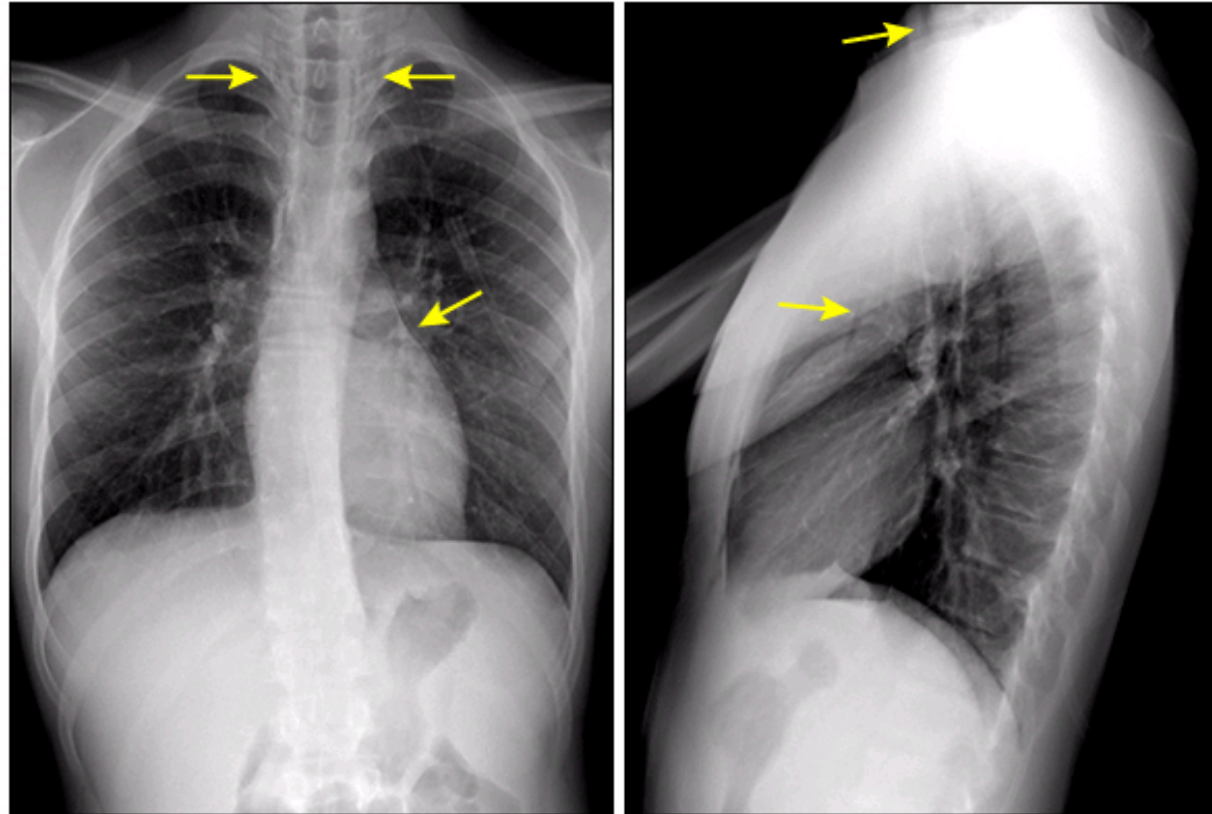

Chest radiograph showing pneumomediastinum

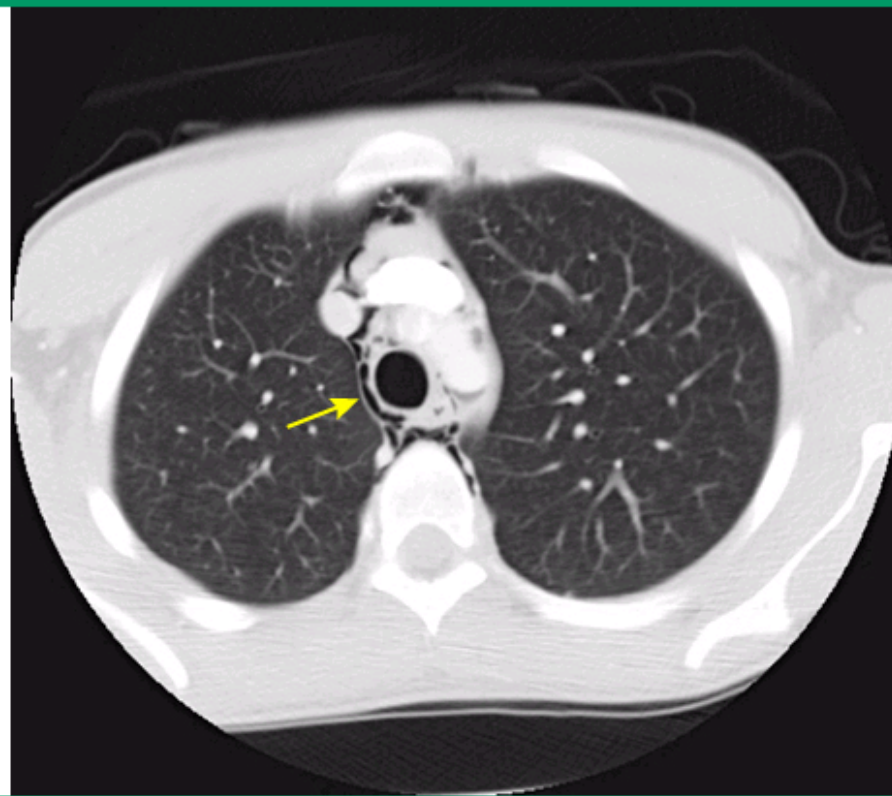

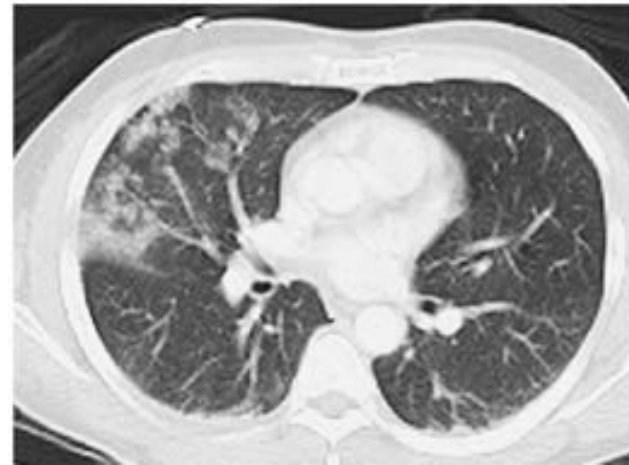
CT scan of pneumomediastinum



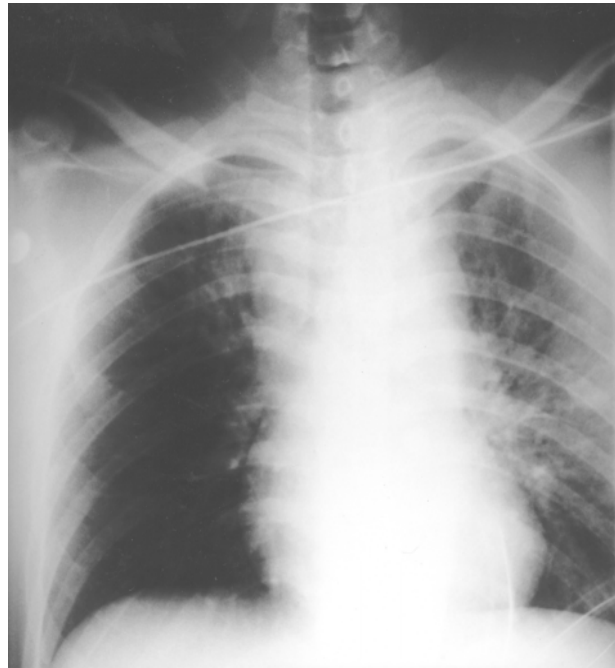
This axial CT of the chest with lung windows demonstrates extensive pneumomediastinum (arrow) in the patient whose plain radiographs appear in the accompanying graphic.
